We are pleased to invite seniors attending one of the Oakland Schools Technical Campuses (OSTC) to apply for the Scholarships for Success Award Program.

## **Scholarship Criteria:**

To be considered for these scholarships, a student must:

1. Be a senior student at one of the OSTC campuses.
2. Have an overall GPA of at least 2.0.
3. Have a career technical education (CTE) program GPA of at least 3.0 (either at OSTC or a district CTE program).
4. Intend to pursue studies at a two- or four-year college/university, apprenticeship or trade school.

## **Application Instructions:**

1. You must submit the Google application by Friday, Feb. 1, 2019.
2. Your application must include the following items:
  - a. A copy of your high school transcript.
  - b. A minimum of two letters of recommendation from a teacher, counselor or employer, etc.

\*One letter of recommendation MUST be from an OSTC campus staff member. The other letter MUST be from someone who knows you in another capacity. You MUST use the Recommendation Form provided.\*

Scholarships will be awarded on the basis of the information provided in the application including essay questions, letters of recommendation and CTE interest and involvement.

**Application deadline:** Friday, Feb. 1, 2019
